“Free” Job Training while you receive “Free” Housing, Meals, Healthcare, Dental Care, a living allowance & clothing allowance & Daycare in some locations!

Job training leading to jobs for:

Economically disadvantaged youth ages 16-24
Veterans 20-24 years of age, Honorably Discharged
People who are disabled (physically or emotionally)
There are many opportunities for young women!

Both Vickers House locations are now accepting applications for the 3 hour orientations! Applications are available at both sites, But if you need assistance filling out the application, Vickers House Staff will assist!

To be eligible:

Be ready, willing, and able to participate fully!

You must be a Citizen or Resident Alien, Social Security cards are required

Must speak /understand English (ESOL courses will be provided to improve your skills)

Academic training includes High School Diploma, GED preparation & College preparatory. College & Advanced Training is also available.

In order to stay in the program, students must not violate the "Zero Tolerance" policy against violence, drugs and sexual harassment. You will not be turned away for a Criminal background – Court documents are required for enrollment.

The program takes anywhere from 11 months to 2 years to complete, (3 years for college or advanced training!)

While you are in training Job Corps offers residential housing, food service, driver's education, basic health and dental care, a bi-weekly basic living allowance and clothing allowance. Some centers offer childcare programs for single parents as well.
